OVER 80 YEARS IN THE MAKING: A History of the Great Smoky Arts & Crafts Community

No one planned it when the Great Smoky Arts & Crafts Community developed in Gatlinburg, it just happened. For years, artists and craftsmen practiced their specialty in downtown Gatlinburg. Sometimes in studios and galleries and more often, out on the street, where visitors and residents could watch them develop their creations. People came and watched, they crafted. 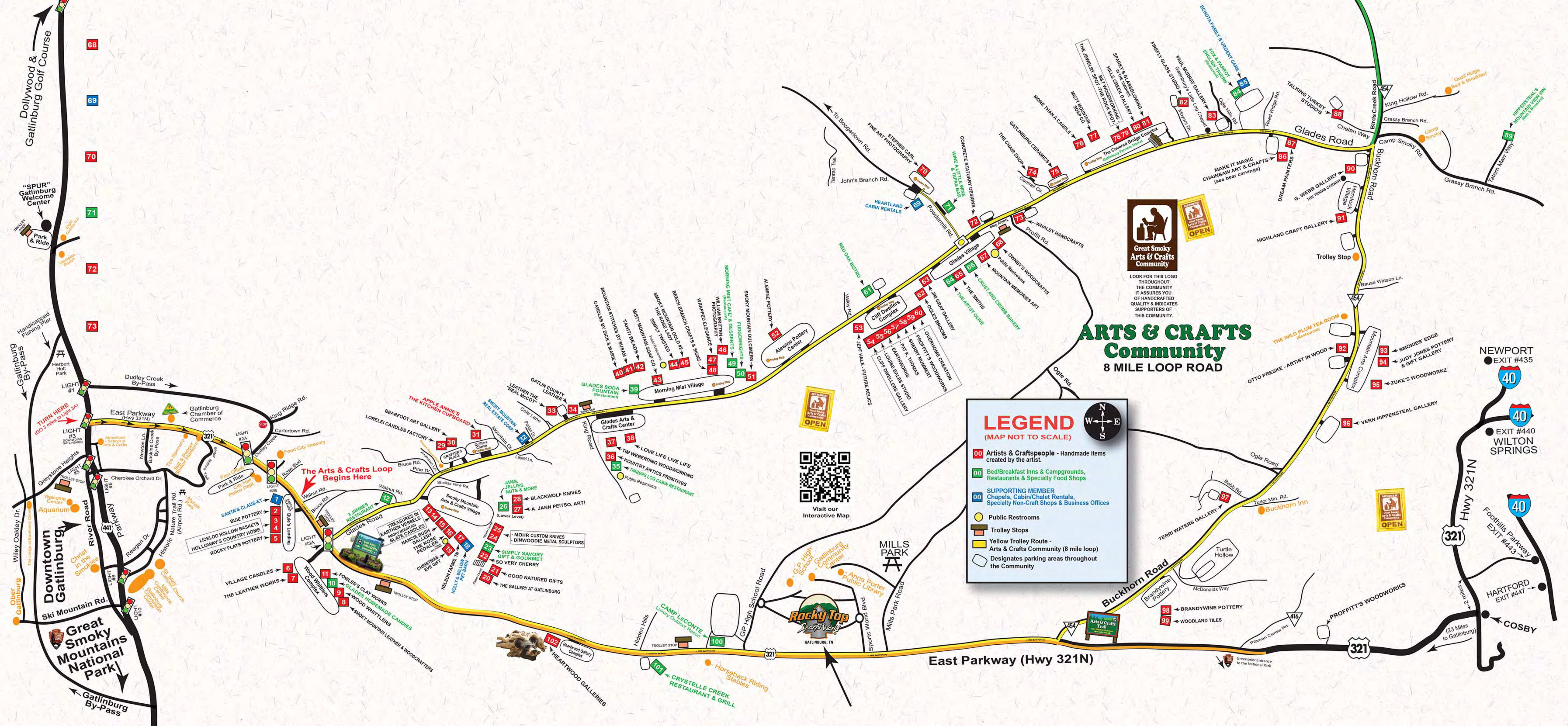

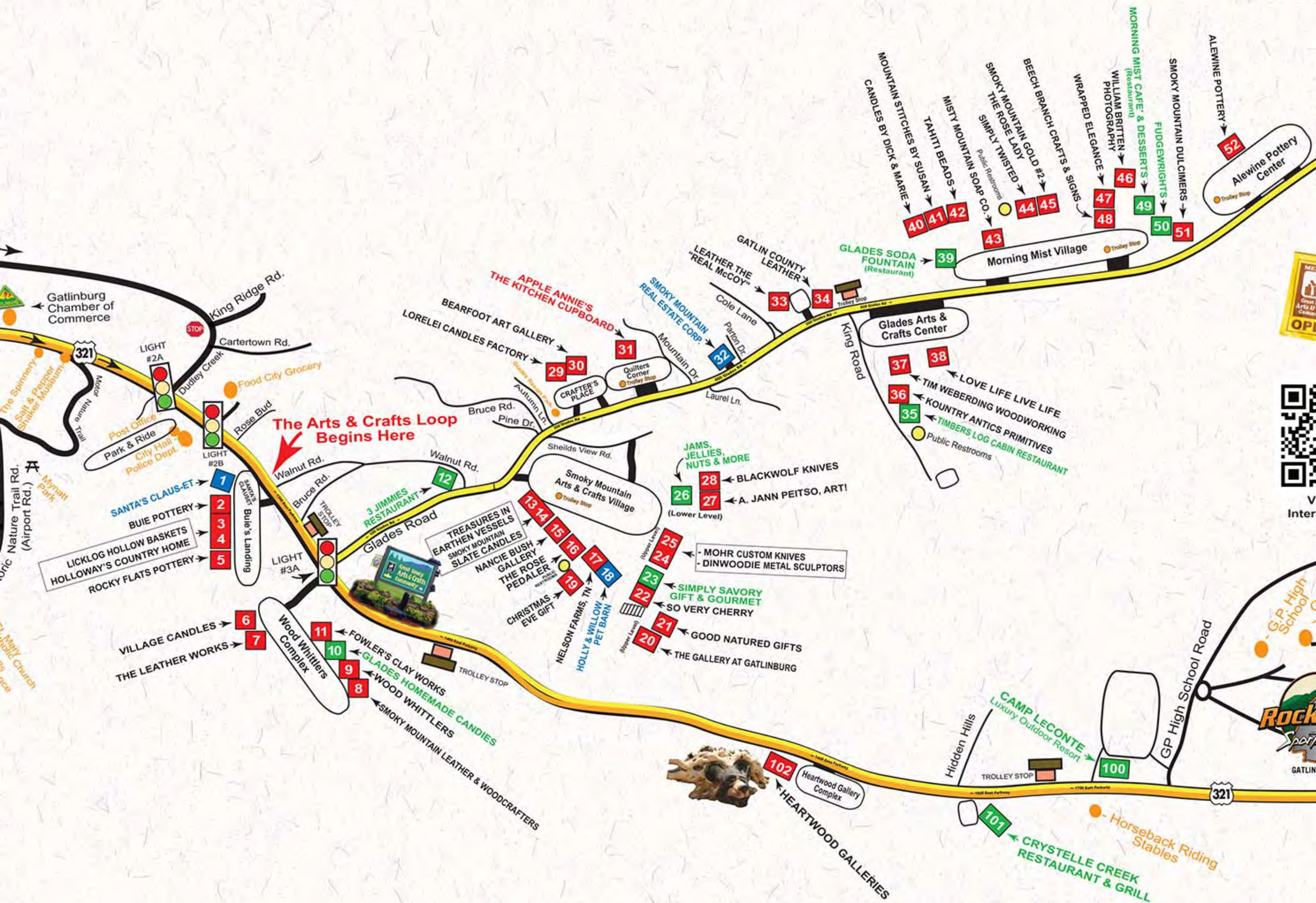
